Maximum stocking rates per surface acre of water are: 100 Channel Cat (5-8”), 1000 hybrid sunfish and 200 bass (3”) Fathead minnows – 1 to 5 pounds per acre. Grass carp stocking rates are generally 4 to 6 per acre and should be stocked depending on the species and abundance of the vegetation. Sterile Grass Carp have been legalized in Illinois and may provide a solution to your weed problem.
